### Regent Sixth Form College will provide:

- A programme of courses delivered by suitably qualified and effective members of staff using appropriate facilities and resources.
- A friendly, caring and supportive environment through a network of pastoral care and personal tutors.
- A programme of counselling and advice that will include extensive support in careers guidance and for the university application process through UCAS by dedicated members of staff.
- A programme of Study Skills to enable students to become more independent learners, capable of organising your time and employing effective methods.
- A system of regular and effective assessment, recording and reporting to monitor and support student progress.
- A diverse programme of extra curricular activities, which will provide support for learning and opportunities for leisure.

### The student will:

- **Code of Conduct** – know and follow the rules and principles contained in the Code of Conduct.
- **Commitment** – demonstrate a commitment to fulfilling their academic potential by fully applying their efforts to study.
- **Independent Learner** – use study time effectively, be conscientious in their approach to homework and coursework by ensuring all deadlines are met, and by seeking the advice and expertise of teachers.
- **Punctual** – attend College every day and arrive on time for every lesson.
- **Contribute** – help the College achieve a sense of community by playing a role in societies and College activities and by helping fellow students.
- **Role Model** – act as a positive role model for the younger pupils in the Senior School by being helpful, respectful and courteous to all members of the College community.
- **Dress Code** – adhere to the Dress Code.

**The family will:**

- **Code of Conduct** – ensure that the student knows and follow the rules and principles contained in the Code of Conduct.
- **Attendance** – ensure that the student attends College and provide a note of explanation if the child is absent.
- **Homework** - ensure that all homework is completed within the time set by the College.
- **Dress Code** – ensure that the student adheres to the Dress Code.
- **Contact Information** – provide up to date and detailed contact details, including email addresses, to ensure that the College and the family can work together to enable the student to fulfil their academic potential.
- **Contribute** – help the College achieve a sense of community by playing a role in College activities and events.
- **Parent’s Evenings** – attend both Parent’s Evenings during the academic year.
- **Changes** - notify the College of any change of circumstances that may affect the student.
