

REGENT COLLEGE A-LEVEL RESULTS 2009

Regent College is a co-educational independent senior school and Sixth Form college located in Harrow, in north-west London. Here at Regent College we have certain aims which direct and govern the way the College is run. We aim to provide opportunities for all students regardless of background, to provide the best possible preparation and support for entry into higher education and the world of work and to encourage students to develop both personally and as a member of society. Yet again, Regent College has had another batch of outstanding A-level results this summer with a fantastic pass rate of 98%. Of particular note were the results received by some of our students on our A-level Intensive programme. This is a special course offered by Regent College allowing students to take the whole A-level, both AS and A2 units, in one year. This programme is particularly popular with students who have already attempted the AS course but not received the results that they had hoped for. This programme allows them to work on the AS material for the January exams and the A2 material for the June exams. This means students have a chance to go over the AS material ensuring full comprehension and resolving any issues they had encountered previously. Alternatively, some students, who for various reasons did not do as well as expected in the traditional two year A-level course, like to repeat the whole course in one year.

On average, students on our Intensive programme improve their results by 2 grades. However, many students who are fully dedicated to taking advantage of this excellent, if demanding, opportunity can achieve much more. For example, Rajan Pandya came to Regent College with grades of EEE. He left with AAB and is now headed to City University to study Economics. Similarly, Priya Patel came to us with grades of DDEU. She now heads to Nottingham University to study Accounting having obtained ABB at A2 and a B at AS. Clearly, for those who are prepared to put the effort in, the results can be outstanding. Another indicator of the success of this programme is our student Shanjay Damani who came from France with no previous experience of A-level work and completed the course in one year. He achieved remarkable results of AAB and is now going to Birmingham University to study Management.

Regent College is also offering a last opportunity to enrol for the Legacy course. This is a course that runs from September 2009 to January 2010. This is a highly demanding programme which allows students to re-sit their A2 modules and is proving a popular choice amongst students who feel that they have not achieved their full potential previously. One of the ways that Regent College intends to ensure that the students are fully prepared for their exams is by introducing weekly tests to ensure that all the work has been understood and that the students are on track to achieve their desired grades.

Students from Regent College go on to a wide variety of destinations, many of them world-renowned, such as Cambridge, London School of Economics and Imperial College amongst others. A large number of our students also go on to traditional, popular red-brick universities including Birmingham, Durham and Warwick and many more.
